3. FALSE 2

Explanation: Commas are used to separate items on a list, therefore it is punctuated correctly and the answer is false.

4. TRUE 2

Explanation: The pronoun, **who** is used so that we do not have to repeat the word "sister".

5. TRUE 2

Explanation: **Homophones** are words that sound the same but have different meanings and spellings.

For example:

pane - a single sheet of glass in a window

pain - an injury or ache

heel - the bottom back part of the foot

heal - becoming healthy again

Explanation: **Panado** is the product that is being advertised, as it is the name of the tablets that appear on the box.

Explanation: The word "first" indicates where Mikhail placed in the race and is thus an adjective of quantity.

Explanation: When we rewrite a sentence from direct to indirect speech, the verb moves on step into the past tense. "It is ironic" becomes "it was ironic" in the past tense.

Explanation: Assonance is the repetition of vowel sounds in consecutive words like "I ate apples in August".

Explanation: "Mayleen" is the subject of the sentence in the Active Voice, therefore in the Passive Voice "Mayleen" will be moved to the end of the sentence, preceded by the word "by".

Explanation: Reflexive pronouns usually end in "-self". It is reflecting back to the noun.

Explanation: In the Passive Voice, you must now swap around the subject ("cat") and the object ("ball"). You must also change the verb and add in the word "by".

Explanation: The personal pronoun "we" is replacing the names (subject) and making it easier and faster to read the sentence.	
18. My idea of good taste	3
Explanation: "My idea of good taste." It is easy to remember and easy to understand.	
19. Smartwater	3
Explanation: Smartwater is the name of the brand. It appears on the bottle in the picture and on the bottom right of the frame.	
20. hasn't	3
Explanation: The subject, Jade, is singular, therefore the verb must also be singular. hasn't - singular haven't - plural	
21. television	3
Explanation: The abbreviation TV is a well-known abbreviation used in everyday speech.	
22. girl	3
Explanation: The girl / child is the most likely person to have touched the TV screen with sticky hands.	
23. TV repairman	3
Explanation: The girl thinks that there is a technical error with the TV that needs to be fixed by a professional.	
24. (1) compound adjective (2) adjective of quantity	4 (2 per answer)
Explanation: A hyphenated adjective is called a compound adjective. An adjective that's a number is an adjective of quantity.
