

- 1944 Gandhi is released from prison
- 1934 Gandhi announces retirement from politics to focus on village economics
- **1908** Gandhi is arrested for the first time, for refusing to carry an obligatory id card in South Africa
- 1948 Gandhi is assassinated
- 1869 Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi is born in Porbandar, Gujarat, India
- **1942 -** Gandhi is arrested after refusing to support Britain during WW2 unless India is given immediate independence
- 1896 He becomes an established political leader in South Africa
