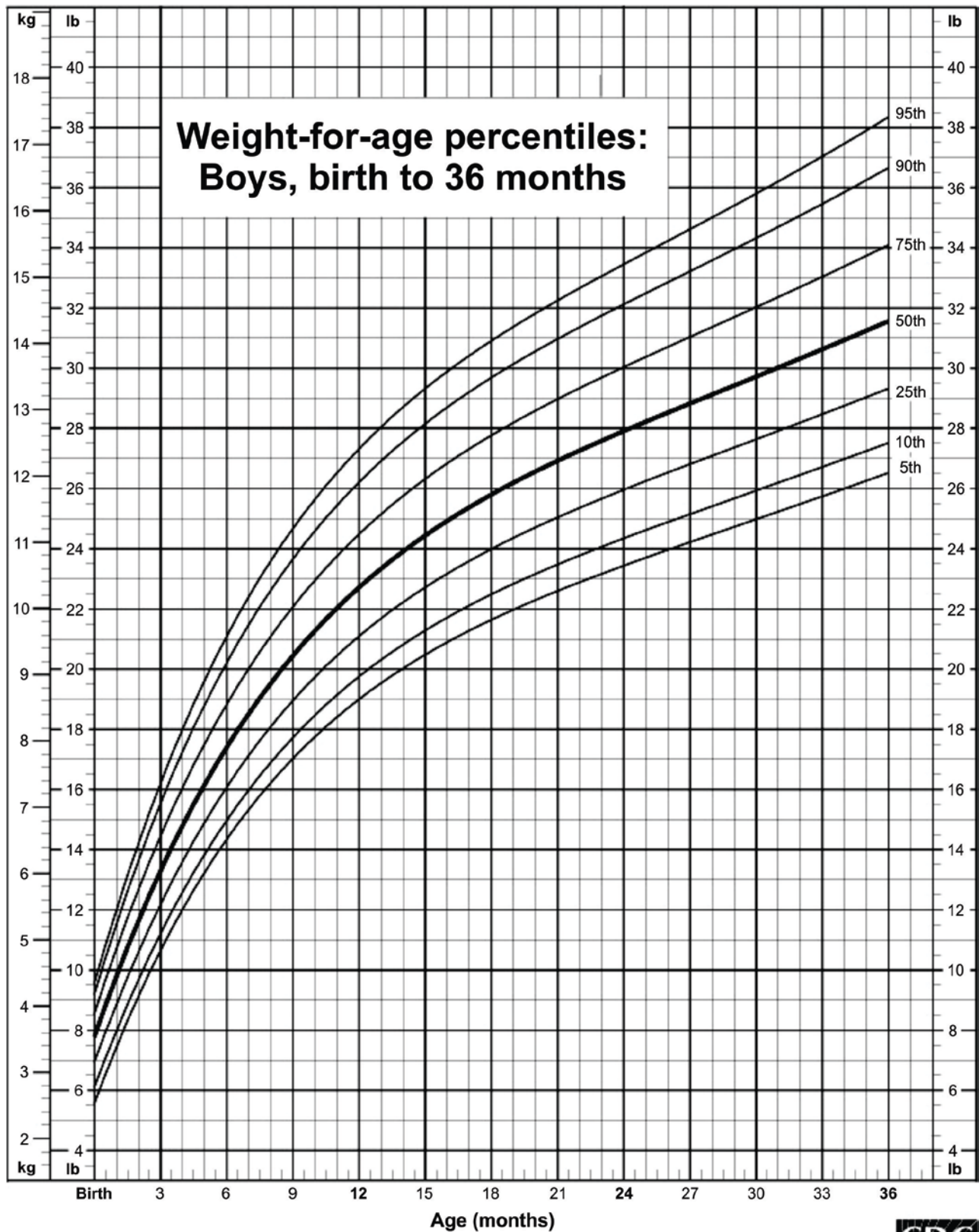

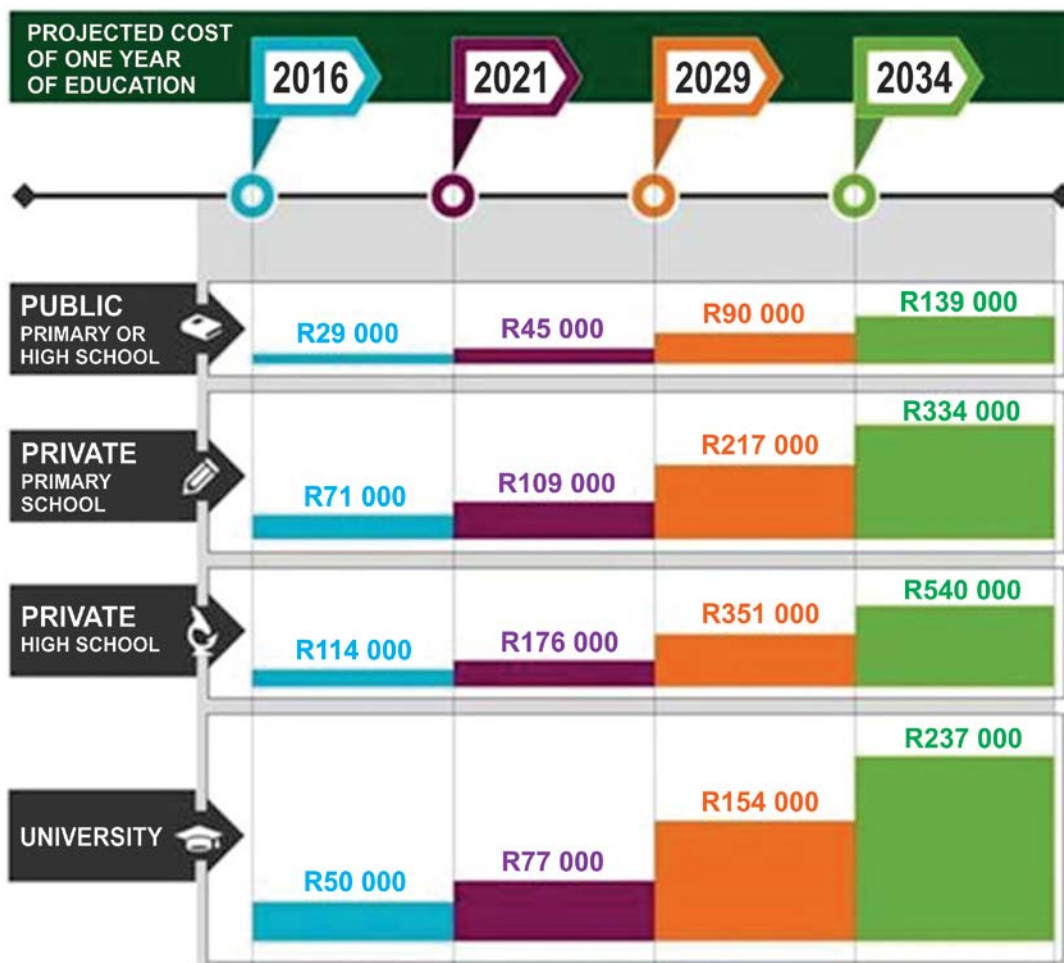
**Projection on the cost of Education**

**EDUCATION – A LOOK AT THE FIGURES**

The cost of education is expected to increase by about 9% per year. This means that in 5 years' time you could be looking at school fees around R45 000 per annum – and that's for a public, not private school!

Education inflation is one of the reasons many of us struggle to save enough to cover the cost of school and university fees (and all those extras). Essentially, education inflation is higher than South Africa's official inflation rate (Consumer Price Index) and this gap has widened from around 2% in the early 2000s to 4% in 2016.

The graph below predicts the **average projected cost per year** for education in the years to come.

*E.g. The average cost of attending a Public Primary School or a Public High School in 2016 is R29 000 per year. For the purposes of the graph, the cost remains the same for 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020.*
